Objectives: Objective of this WP is to provide a reliable inventory of materiel cultural heritage and promote the different activities and dimensions of the <i>katun's</i> life. It is aimed to increase the general awareness of their importance, raise the level of mutual understanding and networking among the people connected with <i>katuns</i> and region in whole, as well as to bring the attention to some of its aspects relevant for sustainable development.							

Description of work and role of participants
<p>This WP will be accomplished by identification of critical aspect of socio-cultural and environmental sustainability and definition of key activities that could prevent and neutralize the negative processes in katuns. In the tasks related to social-economic categories, it will treat both case study areas, while in the fields of cultural heritage and biodiversity preservation; activities will be mainly focused on Kuči mountains area. For Durmitor, having the status of National Park and UNESCO protected area, similar data already exist. Relevant data will be collected from the direct field research, interviews with authorities on the state and local level, as well as the focus groups (farmers, foresters, dairy products' traders, tourism workers etc.) and individual households which raise livestock (c.ca 50 families). Task 2.3 Inventory of material cultural and rural heritage of the Kuči Mountains - HIM, ITABC

This task has to determine and document the real current number, condition and characteristics of the *katuns* on the Mountains of Kuči.

2.3.1. Desk researches - archival and library researches on existing data on historical, social and cultural aspects of the area;

2.3.2 Mapping and GPS positioning of the *katuns*, sites and objects of cultural-historical importance in research area;

2.3.3. Inventorying of the *katuns*, determining their condition, origin and characteristics;

2.3.4. Documenting current condition (photo, video, graphic and textual) of the *katuns*;

2.3.5. Creation of pertaining data base;

Task 2.4 Rural heritage preservation and promotion - HIM, ITABC

Task objective is to enable the easier, better and more comprehensive insight and understanding of different aspects of the *katun's* way of life, its tradition and culture.

2.4.1 Workshop on sustainable preservation and valorisation of the cultural heritage of *katuns*, natural and cultural landscapes (up to 30 persons – scientists, experts, national stakeholders, public body representatives, NGO-s, workers in touristic sector local representatives);

2.4.2 Preparing the photo monograph on Mountains' of Kuči *katuns*.

Task 2.5 Raising the public awareness and social responsibility on sustainable use of the resources-HIM, BTF

The task objective is to provide the attracting of much greater public attention to the issues affecting the contemporary life on the *katuns*, as well as preparing the local community to deal with the most significant ones;

2.5.1 sustainable forest management including fire and erosion protection and wildlife management (1 day workshop for rural society representatives, farmers, private forest owners, foresters on two localities) (leaflet on the topic will be printed));
